

# Tilecoat



**TILECOAT** is a cement-based tile adhesive with additives that increase initial adhesion and allow for greater workability in terms of time and ease of adjustment. It is used for fixing mosaic, ceramic stone, clay porcelain and wall and floor tiles.

## APPLICATION

- Tile coat may be used in normal methods of fixing that is solid bed, ribbed bed and spot.
- The recommendation is that for external use, solid bed should be used.
- Surplus tilecoat should be removed before setting.
- Use the correct tiling tools, press tiles firmly into wet adhesive full contact between the tile and the adhesive.
- Tiles must be allowed to dry for 24hours before grouting.

## USES

- It is used for fixing mosaic, ceramic stone, clay porcelain, wall and floor tiles.

## SURFACE PREPARATION

- The surface to which the tiles are to be fixed must be clean free of dust, grease, oil, wax polish, and organic matter.
- The surface must be firm and free from excess movement due to shrinkage.

## COVERAGE

- Coverage solid bed 10m<sup>2</sup> = 20kg bag Ribbed bed 20m<sup>2</sup> = 20kg bag.

## STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

- Should be stored under dry conditions. Tile coat may be stored for period of up to 1 year.
